



Dear Rec Center Ministries Teammate,

Thank you for your registration for the Rec Center Ministries PowerCamp 2008. Your registration(s) has been accepted in the sport clinic that you desire. We are very excited that your son(s) and/or daughter(s) will participate in this exciting sports camp!

This year's camp will be at the Pleasant Valley School in Mullica Hill, NJ from July 14th to the 17th. Registration for the first day will be from 8:30 a.m. until 8:55 a.m. where your child will receive a Rec Center Ministries Bible, Rec Center Ministries camp T-shirt, be assigned a team, and turn-in the necessary medical and pick-up forms. The program starts at 9:00 a.m. so please plan accordingly. Each morning thereafter, drop-off of children will be from 8:30 a.m. until 8:55 a.m. Children **must be walked in every morning by a parent** and signed in at the registration table. At the end of the day, pick-up of all children will be done on a sign-out basis where the parent, or whoever you authorized when your child was registered, will sign-out your children at 3:30 p.m. The all-volunteer staff would appreciate timely pick-up. **Please complete your pick-up form for each child attending and return it on the first day at registration. Only those on your pick-up form will be allowed to sign-out any children.**

Also enclosed is a form that consents to treat your child in case of a medical emergency. **This form must also be turned in on the first day.** Additionally, please inform us of any allergy or minor medical problems for your child. Camp staff will handle only emergency care; if your child requires daily medical attention, please contact the Rec Center Ministries office for coordination. If your child is sick, please keep them home for the day.

Additionally, each camper must bring **every day a lunch and a water bottle.** Children participating in the **soccer camp must bring a soccer ball and wear shin guards.** Please mark all of your children's items with their name and keep them together in one bag. **Children should wear tennis or running shoes and bring their cleats with them.**

As a reminder, the camp will have **a special session on Thursday night, July 17, from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. held at Trinity UMC at 284 Cedar Road, Mullica Hill.** It is being held at the church this year as we need a larger space with better quality sound capabilities. Parents, siblings, friends, and campers are all invited back for dinner at 6:00 p.m. These programs are always fun for the kids; Andrew Little, a favorite of all the kids, will be this year's speaker and is a must see for all parents. Enclosed is an RSVP letter concerning the dinner. Please invite anyone.

Lastly, Rec Center Ministries is a volunteer non-profit organization. This camp **always needs more help** with your time, talents, and financial resources.
